  previous year from the previous owner need to be paid off at the time of closing. Otherwise they need to be
  taken off the tax bill, as they are not transferable.
- \$780.00 needs to be taken off of Keith Killorian's tax bill for lawn mowing, as this was not taken care of at closing. He is a new owner; therefore, he is not responsible because the special assessment cannot be transferred. Motion by Arnold Eggert, seconded by Chris Gust to remove the grass mowing special assessment charge from the new owner's tax bill. Motion carried.
