# MEETING MINUTES

## Village of Port Hope Council Meeting

May 10, 2021

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Village President Gary Schave. Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was recited.

- Motion by Roy Reinke, second by Ron Steinhorst to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- Motion by Gene Schuett, second by Ron Steinhorst to approve the minutes of the 4/12/2021 meeting with removing the sewer rates from minutes. Motion carried.

### Reports:

- **Sewer** – Raise monthly fee to \$2.00 paid and \$1.00 unpaid effective for the next billing cycle; also effective July 1, 2021 garbage to be raised by .50 cents. Motion by Jim Hunter, second by Roy Reinke. Motion carried.
- **Streets** – Applied for grant in the amount of \$124,684.50 to resurface Old Main and State streets. It is not known if it has been approved yet.
- **Fire Department** – New truck purchased.
- **Marina** – Over half rented, about 6 slips left at this time

- **Pay Bills** – Motion by Steve Schulz, second by Roy Reinke to approve bills of \$397,010.28. Motion carried.

### New Business:

- **Old Bill's Bar Building** – Someone may be interested
- **Jim Hunter for Historical Society** – Requested to allow the Port Hope Area Historical Society to reactivate existing sewer service at the 8016 Portland Avenue address at no cost to the Historical Society. \$3500.00 to connect, new at no cost. Never disconnected. Depot has donated until reconnect. Motion to approve Historical Society Request by Gene Schuett, seconded by Roy Reinke. Roll call: Reinke: yes Schuett: yes Schulz: yes Steinhorst: yes Hunter: abstained. Rich Harp to do article for paper in the future.
- **Survey Needed** - Motion by Jim Hunter, seconded by Ron Steinhorst that we proceed with further surveying of the parcel, Huron Street and Lake Huron.
- **Set Fire Stand By Rates** – Rate to remain the same. Motion by Roy Reinke, second by Ron Steinhorst that ½ mil be assessed to the taxable value of each township. Motion carried.
