June 11, 2018

- **Marina** – Going well – only 5 slips are left, have 10 seasonal launches.

- **Foreclosures in Town** – Joe Borelli's house are available for the village to purchase ahead of the public auction as well as Anna DeFoor's.

- Jim Hunter would like to donate to the village sidewalk forms from Harbor Beach that his father, R.B. Hunter bought 30 years ago. They work great according to the Depot volunteers who recently used them.
