- **Flyover Demonstration** - Cliff Stuehmer gave presentation of flyovers – 6 A10's per month could increase to 672 a month. A unified response is needed from townships in opposition of this – council would need to prepare a resolution. International Guard was asked to do a flyover demonstration, however they said that it was too expensive.

Going forward, it will have to be identified in the ordinance what is to be allowed.
