COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

June 10, 2019

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Village President Gary Schave. Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was recited.

- o Motion by Chris Gust, seconded by Roy Reinke to approve the agenda. Motion carried.
- o Motion by Jim Hunter, second by Chris Gust to approve the minutes of the 5/13/19 meeting. Motion carried.

Reports:

- o **Sewer** – Nothing new to report
- o **Streets** – Gravel to be completed on Huron Street before the 4th of July
- o **Fire Department** – Truck repaired, siren in old hall being used until the other one is fixed
- o **Marina** – Water level is up; Dan Koglin has put stone in the hole; another slip was sold; geese are moving back in, however company is coming back to spray for free when there has been no rain for 72 hours to prove it really works.

Old Business:

- o **Pay Bills** – Motion by Roy Reinke, second by Jim Hunter to pay bills of \$13,802.78. Motion carried.
- o **Wage Committee Results** – Committee met to discuss wages with results being Clerk @ \$400 per month, Treasurer @ \$325 per month, and Secretary @ \$303 per month. Motion by Jim Hunter to accept wage committee's proposal, second by Steve Schulz. Motion carried.

New Business:

- o **Fireworks Donation** - Motion by Gene Schuett, second by Ron Steinhorst to donate \$500 to the Fireworks. Motion carried
- o **Donation** - Chamber took up a collection at last meeting and gave village \$100 for flowers. It was suggested that a thank you note be sent.
- o **Military Training Patterns** – Changing along the shoreline. Ron Steinhorst to do some research to bring back to the council in the future. Some of the smaller communities have been opposing this. Huron, Tuscola and Sanilac Counties will be affected. Definitely something to look in to.

Communications/Correspondence/Public Comments:

- o Don Goetze to first talk to residents about unlicensed vehicles on property, then a letter will be sent – all vehicles should be registered and insured. He also talked to Ferris about residential parking – there is to be no parking in a front yard. Travel trailers, boat trailers may only be parked in rear yard, but not on street. At night should not be parked on streets, only side or rear lot. Don was questioning whether he should go back to Ferris or is ordinance ok as is.
