May 13, 2019

Reports:

- **Sewer** – Getting ready to drain
- **Streets** – Heinemann and Huron Street set for gravel at a cost of \$23,000
- **Fire Department** – Truck repaired to correct injector
- **Marina** – Docks are in; Dan Koglin did some excavating work; area to be sprayed for geese for free to prove that it works, however there has to be no rain for 72 hours
- **Pay Bills** – Motion by Chris Gust, seconded by Ron Steinhorst to pay bills of \$30,607.92
- **Sewer Problem in Lighthouse Cove** – Chris Gust was unable to contact

New Business:

- **Old Tires** - Soil Conservation District is taking car and truck tires, no tractor tires
- **Wages** - Salary committee is going to meet to review secretary, treasurer and clerk wages – time set for 4:00 p.m. on May 14
- **Recycling** – When handled through Waste Management it doubles the price. There is a trailer in the Harbor Beach City Hall parking lot that accepts certain recycling items.
- **Catch Basins in Town** - Working with county to be cleaned out

Communications/Correspondence/Public Comments:

- MML sent correspondence relating to a 15% savings in tuition at CMU for MML employees, members and their families for online programs and classes taken at CMU's satellite locations
- When trees fall down in the creek in town, it is the homeowner's responsibility. There are several dead ash trees blocking the creek

- Resident's trailer is off the lot, currently parked on a road – Don Goetze to check the ordinance and update
